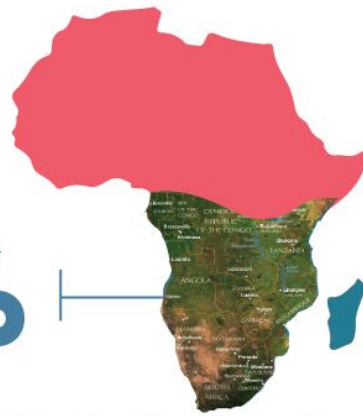

## **fewer than 40% of the indicators for the SDGs have sufficient data to track progress accurately on the continent**

While it is worthy to note that the lack of strong data culture is an African Problem. Case in point, the latest African Governance Report highlights “data challenges” across the continent: only one third of data sources on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) indicators on Africa are from direct country sources and, on average, fewer than 40% of the indicators for the SDGs have sufficient data to track progress accurately on the continent, it states.
